

## Privacy policy

This information is provided according to art. 13 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679 (so-called "GDPR") of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 "relating to the protection of individuals concerning the processing of personal data, as well as to the free movement of such data and which repeals Directive 95/46 / CE (general data protection regulation) "to those who interact with the Web services of IBD Italian Biomedical Devices srl, accessible from the address <https://www.ibdbiomed.com> corresponding to the home page of IBD Italian Biomedical Devices srl's official website.

The information is provided only for the IBD Italian Biomedical Devices srl website and not for other websites that may be consulted by the user through links.

The information also presents, as a specific regulatory reference, the provision of the national Guarantor for the protection of personal data no. 229 of 8 May 2014 "identification of the simplified procedures for the information and the acquisition of consent for the use of cookies - 8 May 2014", as published in the Official Gazette no. 126 of 3 June 2014 and the relative clarifications showed at the following link: <http://www.garanteprivacy.it/web/guest/home/docweb/-/docweb-display/docweb/4006878>

The purpose of the provision being to identify some minimum requirements for the collection of personal data online, and, in particular, the methods, times and nature of the information that the data controllers must provide to users when they connect to web pages, regardless of the purpose of the link.

### The Data Controller

Following consultation of this site, data relating to identified or identifiable persons may be processed. ### Types of data processed

During their normal operation, the IT systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This is information that is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but which by its very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified.

This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users who connect to the site, the URI (so-called "Uniform Resource Identifier") addresses of the resources requested, the time of the request, the method used in submitting the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's computer environment.

These data are used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its correct functioning. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the site only at the request of the supervisory bodies in charge.

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mails to the addresses indicated on this site entails the subsequent acquisition of the sender's address, necessary to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data included in the message.

### Optional supply of data

Apart from that specified for navigation data, the user is free to provide personal data contained in the request forms to IBD Italian Biomedical Devices srl or indicated in contacts to request the sending of informative material or other communications. Their absence may make it impossible to obtain what is requested.

## Juvenile

Following art. 8 of the GDPR, no person under the age of 16, without the prior consent of the parents or whoever takes their place, will be able to send information to this website, nor will it be able to make purchases or perfect legal acts at this site without the aforementioned consent, unless this is permitted by applicable law.

## Processing methods

Personal data are processed with automated tools for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected. Following art. 32 of the GDPR, specific security measures are observed to prevent the loss of data, illicit or incorrect use, and unauthorized access.

## Rights of data subjects

The subjects to whom the personal data refer have the right at any time to obtain confirmation of the existence or otherwise of the same data and to know its content and origin (ref. Art.15, GDPR "right of access of the interested party "), Verify its accuracy or request its integration or updating, or rectification (ref. Art.16, GDPR" right of rectification "). According to the GDPR, you also have the right to request cancellation or transformation into anonymous form (ref. Art. 17 "right to cancellation") or limitation or blocking (ref. Art. 18 "right to limitation of treatment" ) of data processed in violation of the law, as well as to revoke (ref. art. 7, paragraph 3 "conditions for consent") or oppose in any case, for legitimate reasons, (ref. art. 21 "right of opposition" and art. 77 "right to complain with the supervisory authority") to their treatment.

## USE OF COOKIES
